- Students completing dual credit and who wish to enroll at Monmouth directly after high school graduation will apply as a first-time freshman and be eligible for freshman level scholarships.
- Students completing dual credit and who wish to continue their studies at Carl Sandburg after high school graduation will apply as a transfer student when ready to transfer from Carl Sandburg to Monmouth.

Transfer Notes:

- Courses taken at Carl Sandburg College in which the student earned a passing grade of D or higher may be transferred
 to Monmouth College. Note that a C or better is required to receive transfer credit for English Composition, Speech, and any
 classes applying to a major or minor.
- · College credit will only be applied when an official Carl Sandburg transcript has been received.
- A maximum of 64 credit hours may be transferred.
