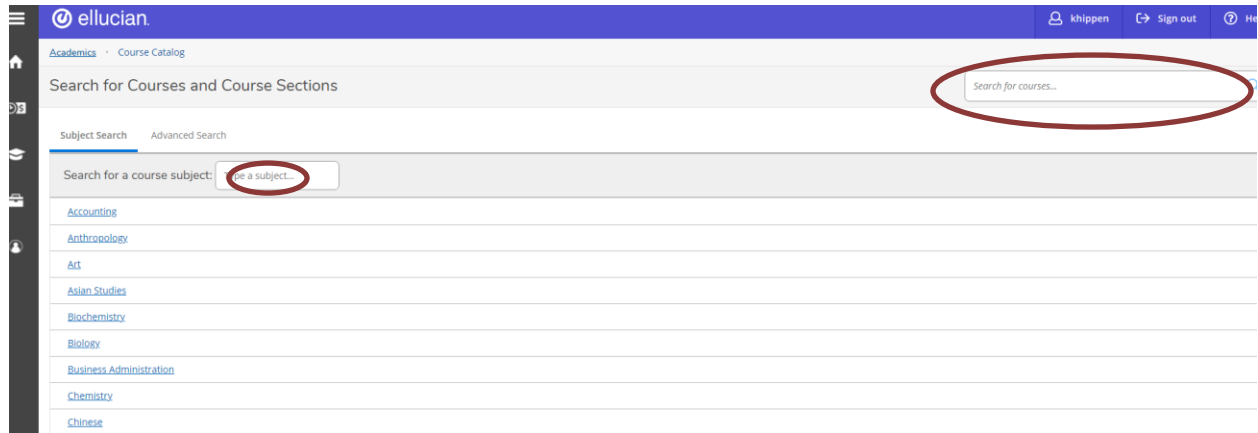


Course Catalog Tutorial
